Facility:

Outside the track area are 2 long jump runways, pole vault pit, shot put area, discus circle with a cage and a high jump area.

Officiating:

There will be NO OFFICIATING duties for participating schools. All duties will be operated by volunteers and AO officials. Head track official will be St. Francis; head jumps official will be St. Francis and head throws official will be St. Paul.

Age Classification:

Novice - under age 15 as of January 1st, of the current school year, and in grade 9. Junior - under age 16 as of January 1st, of the current school year.

Senior - under age 20 as of January 1st, of the current school year.

Eligibility:

This meet is open to high school athletes only. Athletes must be entered by their coach and a school coach must be present at all times throughout the meet.
